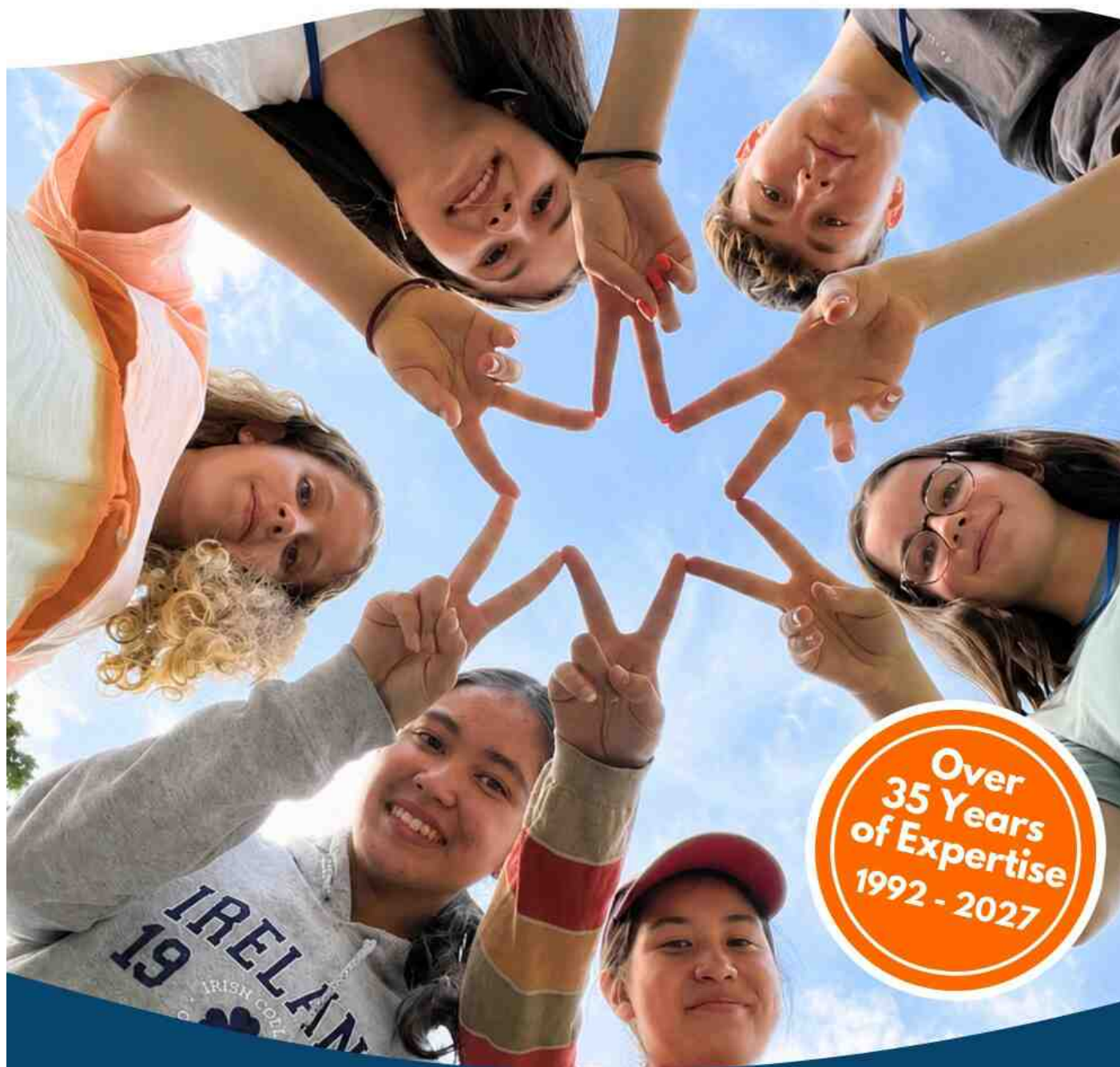

Any additional services, such as airport transfers, are available upon booking.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

BUILDING ENGLISH FLUENCY

Progression is our focus - we aim to develop both fluency and a love of the language. Lessons are held every morning, Monday to Friday, following a carefully planned junior focused syllabus and curriculum. We place special emphasis on speaking and listening, using interactive exercises and task-based projects to refine communication skills.

Teachers monitor student performance through class participation, weekly tasks and formative and summative assessments. Students may transfer levels when assessments show readiness. Students receive a Certificate of Attainment and a Personalised Progress Report showing CEFR level and progress.

INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES

CEFR-ALIGNED LEARNING

Our syllabus is fully aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and 'can do' descriptors, ensuring structured, measurable progress in all skills.

REAL-WORLD LANGUAGE USE

Task-based learning and project work help students apply language in meaningful ways - from presentations and cultural projects to collaborative problem-solving activities that reflect real-life situations.

INTERACTIVE, DYNAMIC CLASSES

Lessons are student-centred and engaging, encouraging participation through pair work, group activities, and lively discussions that develop natural communication skills.

CULTURAL CONNECTION

Irish Cultural Modules link classroom learning to the social activity programme, introducing Ireland's history, traditions, and everyday life. Students gain not only language skills but also cultural awareness.



QUALITY TUITION

All our English teachers are fully qualified professionals, holding recognised teaching credentials to ensure the highest standards of language education.

As part of our academic policy, students are evaluated pre-arrival through our online CEFR aligned placement test.

Students are evaluated again on their first day through in-class assessment to ensure correct placement.

Teachers monitor student performance through class participation, weekly tasks and formative and summative assessments.

LEVEL CHANGES

Students may transfer levels when assessments show readiness.

INTERCULTURAL IRISH TEENAGE PROGRAMME

As part of our continuous efforts to maintain high quality classes and to enhance our students' experience, we have introduced our unique Intercultural Irish Teenage Programme.

Each week Irish teenagers join lessons to lead an exercise alongside our teachers, giving our students the opportunity to connect with young Irish people. We have had an incredibly positive response to this programme.

MODERN LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Our classrooms are equipped with interactive projectors, speaker systems, and writable walls. Teachers integrate:

- Videos, TED Talks, and authentic materials
- Digital games and interactive quizzes
- Multimedia content relevant to teenage learners
- CEFR guides and visual goals to guide progress

EXTRA SUPPORT & RESOURCES

We provide pre-arrival course information, student handbooks, and CEFR-aligned resources to make learning transparent and clear. Weekly updates and progression goals are communicated to students. Optional reflective journals connect learning to real-life experiences.



ACCOMMODATION

HOMESTAY PROGRAMMES

Homestay Programmes offer students a safe, welcoming and immersive experience of Irish family life and culture. Uniquely, all host families are located within a 4 km radius of the school. Our comprehensive quality assurance procedures include regular home visits and ongoing student feedback, helping us maintain consistently high standards across our host family network.

OUR HOSTS

Our hosts typically welcome 2–3 students at a time, with one nationality per home to encourage English use. We take great care in matching each student with hosts to ensure comfort and compatibility. Living with hosts allows students to practise English naturally, make lasting connections, and feel part of a warm home environment.

HOSTS WITHIN 4 KM RADIUS

All Homestays are within a 4 km radius of the school. Homes are within walking distance or a short bus journey, and all students receive a Dublin Travel Pass for the duration of their stay.

NATIONALITY MIX

To encourage students to speak English and make new international friends, we place only one student of each nationality with each host family.

MEALS, LAUNDRY & DAILY LIFE

Hosts provide breakfast, a packed lunch, and an evening meal each day. Meals are nutritious and balanced, and we can cater for special dietary requirements on request. On arrival, students receive a refillable water bottle for use throughout their stay. Hosts take care of students as part of their daily routine, including doing their laundry.

CURFEW

As part of our child protection procedures, students are permitted free time in the local area after dinner. A strict 9.30pm curfew applies to all students participating in our Homestay Programmes.



RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMMES

Our residential accommodation options are designed with teenagers in mind. We are based in two of Ireland's premier private boarding schools, giving students the opportunity to live and learn in purpose-built, fully supervised residential settings. These exceptional campuses offer a safe and structured space, designed for teenagers, where students can make friends, grow in confidence, and enjoy a real sense of community.

CLONGOWES WOOD COLLEGE

Clongowes Wood College offers a mix of single and twin rooms/cubicles. Some rooms are stand-alone, while others are in a cubicle format opening onto a larger recreational area. Male and female students are accommodated in separate areas. Shared toilets and showers are located on each floor.

MEALS AND DAILY LIFE

Across both of our residential centres, our excellent catering teams provide freshly prepared hot meals at breakfast, lunch and dinner, along with an evening snack. Food is high quality, locally sourced and varied, with a wide selection to suit different tastes and ensure students are well nourished and energised throughout the day.

GLENSTAL ABBEY

Glenstal Abbey offers dormitory-style rooms with 2–8 students per room. Male and female students are accommodated in separate areas. Shared toilets and showers are located on each floor.

LAUNDRY

A free weekly laundry service is provided at both residences.



ACTIVITY PROGRAMMES

Our activity programmes are a key part of the ICE experience, giving students the opportunity to practise their English naturally while making international friendships and creating unforgettable memories. Led by our enthusiastic and experienced ICE activity team, every activity is carefully organised to be safe, engaging, and enjoyable. From cultural visits and sports to evening events and a variety of exciting attractions, our programme offers a rich and rewarding experience that gives students the very best of Ireland.

HOMESTAY PROGRAMMES

Our homestay programmes offer students a rich variety of activities designed to make the most of their time in Ireland. Every weekday students take part in supervised activities, allowing students to explore Ireland, make international friends, and practise their English in real-life situations. The programme features a wide variety of experiences, including sightseeing, sports, cultural visits, beach games, team challenges, and much more.

All homestay students are provided with a Dublin Travel Pass for the duration of their stay allowing easy travel to and from school and afternoon activities. All activities are fully supervised by our experienced staff. All excursions and activities are fully included in the programme cost.



Leisure & Sports:

Enjoy a wide range of fun and active experiences such as bowling, treasure hunts, sports days, and scenic outdoor adventures like the Howth Cliff Walk or Dalkey Hill Walk. These activities encourage teamwork, fitness, and friendship.



City & Cultural Visits:

Explore Dublin's top attractions with guided tours and engaging cultural experiences like the Dublin City Tour, Malahide Castle Tour, National Gallery of Ireland, National Museum of Archaeology, Irish Music Sessions, and traditional Irish Dancing lessons.



Full-Day Excursions:

Every Saturday, students take a full-day trip to see some of Ireland's most famous landmarks. Destinations, such as Glendalough and Kilkenny give students the opportunity to experience Ireland's natural beauty and historic sites.

Evening Activity:

Students also enjoy our weekly evening activity, e.g. discos, games night, where students can socialise with friends from around the world in a safe and supervised environment.

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMMES

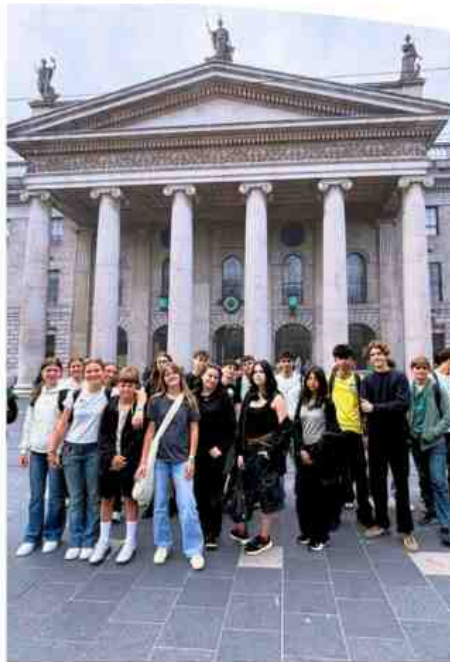
Our residential programmes combine on-site activities with exciting off-site excursions, ensuring a balanced and stimulating schedule every week. Students enjoy afternoons off-site and a variety of events within our beautiful campus grounds.

For all off-site activities, private coaches are used to ensure safety, comfort, and punctuality. All excursions are fully supervised by our dedicated staff.



On-Site Activities:

Take advantage of our outstanding sports facilities and spacious campus for activities such as sports days, swimming, basketball, tennis, and social sports. Creative workshops like art classes, photography, and music sessions are also part of the on-site experience.

STUDENT WELFARE & SAFEGUARDING

At ICE, student welfare is at the heart of everything we do. Our experienced teachers and Academic Management Team provide continuous academic guidance, regular feedback, and personalised support to help every student achieve their learning goals in line with the CEFR. We encourage active participation through interactive lessons, group projects, cultural visits, and activities that build confidence and communication skills.

Our dedicated team is always available to offer advice, encouragement, and assistance, ensuring every student feels supported throughout their stay.

Students' safety and wellbeing are our top priority. We offer a **24/7 emergency number**, and our caring team provides regular check-ins, guidance, and support, ensuring every student feels safe, happy, and at home.

Students are supported by our experienced staff, with strict staff to student ratios based on the activity and a minimum 1:20.

Our residential programmes provide a secure fully supervised boarding school environment, while our homestay programmes are based in Malahide, a safe and welcoming coastal village. All ICE staff and hosts are Garda vetted (Police checked) and receive training in child welfare and protection.

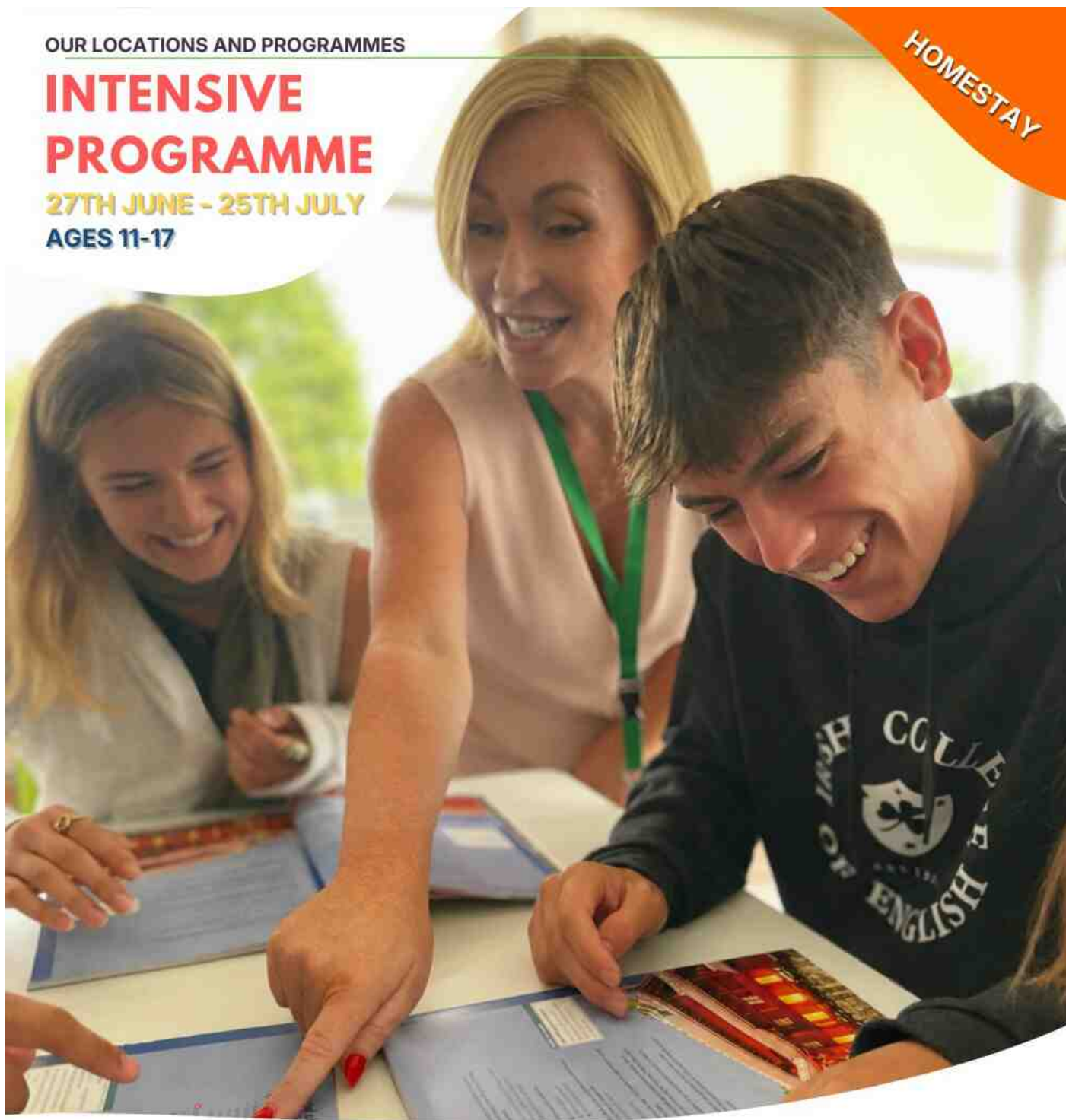

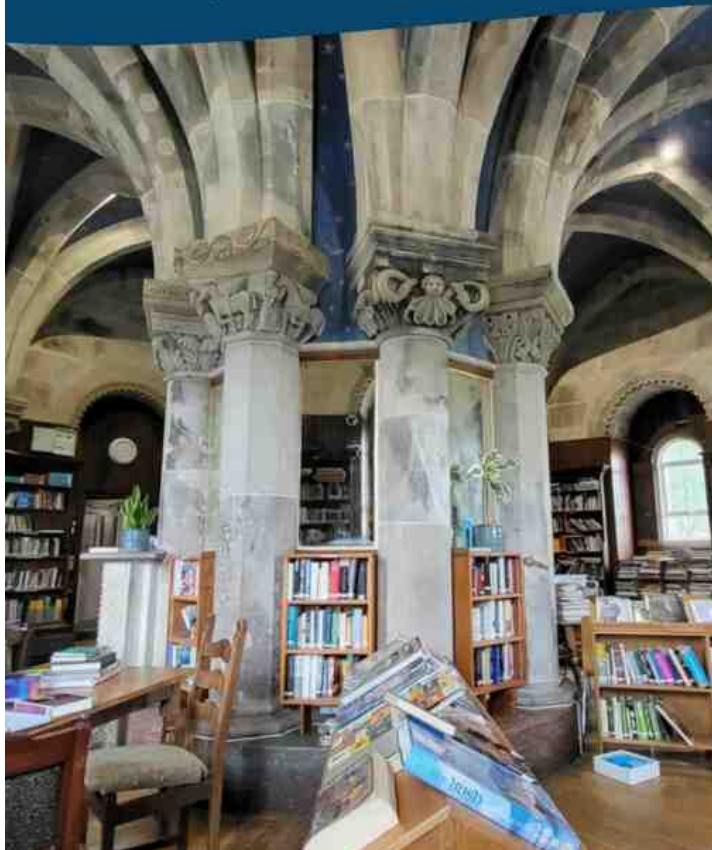

Transfer Procedures

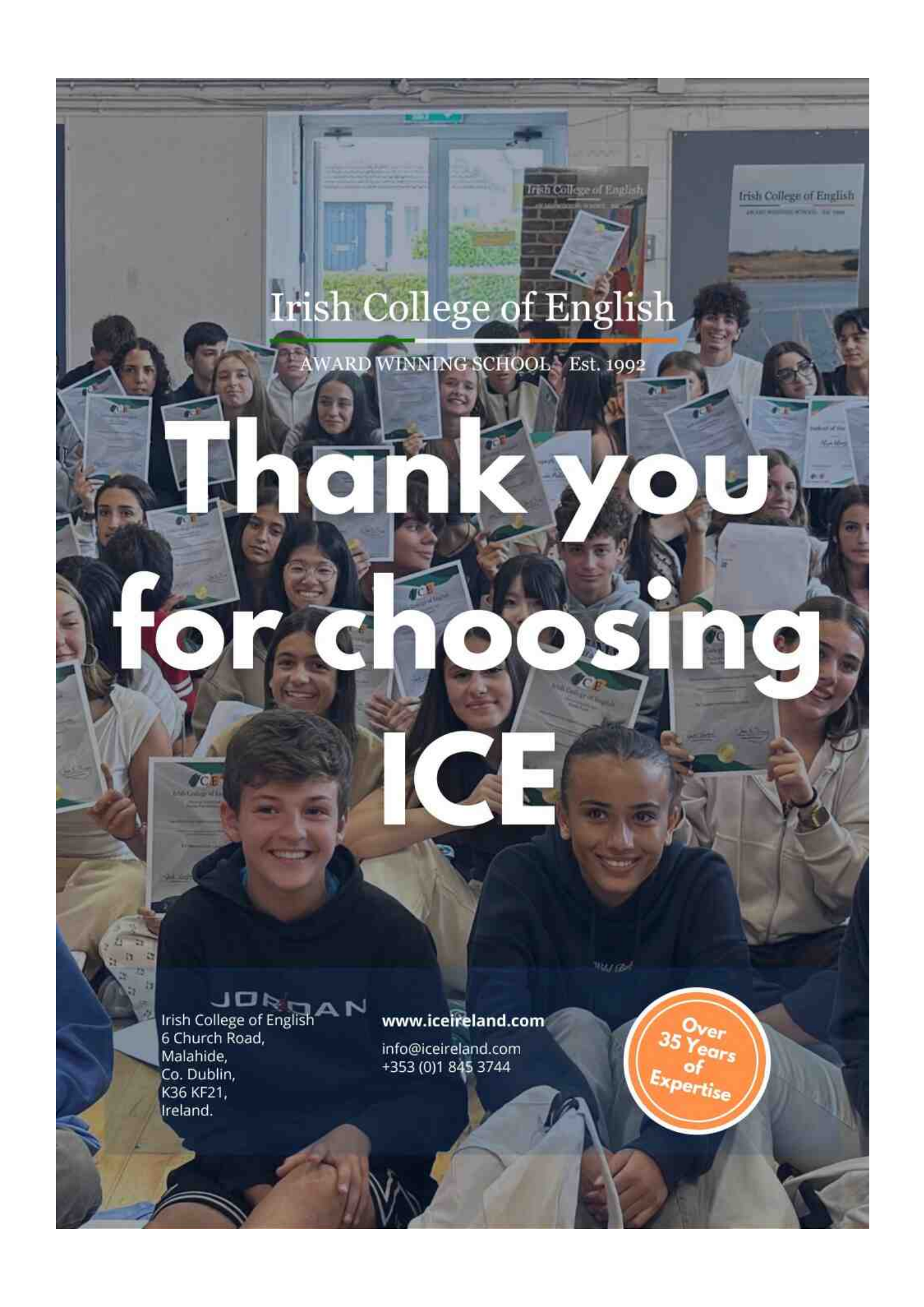
